Class 10. Ridden Novice Walk and Trot Genuine Novice Horse or Riders please, not open to lead reins 9 and under, novice older riders can be assisted and will be judged accordingly ^

Class 11. Open Mountain and Moorland not open to lead-rein ^

Class 12. Riding Club Pony or Horse There will be a small fence to jump for the riding club pony/horse, snaffle bridles only for these classes ^

Class 13. Open Pony 14.2hh and under

Class 14. Open Horse over 14.2hh

Class 15. Ridden Veteran Horse or pony 15yrs of age or over ^

Class 16. Ridden Coloured Includes Dun, Palomino, Roan & Spotted ^
